Kia ora and welcome back to you all. I hope the break was great for you and your family. It was so nice seeing all the children coming back and so positive for school this morning. A special welcome to all our brand-new parents and children.

There are a couple of important events coming up quickly this term.

This week, each hub will be sending home an information form for your child. The information forms the basis of the conversations and goal setting between your child and their class teacher for the year. As part of this process, there are **parent/teacher get to know each other conversations** happening next week and the following week. These are on **Wednesdays and Thursdays (10th and 11th and 17th and 18th) from 3.00 until 5.30pm.** This us a great opportunity for you to sit and chat with your child's teacher face to face and talk through your hopes and aspirations for the year. Secondly, coming up in Week 5 but best to diary it now is a **Teacher Only day on March 5th.** I flagged this last year but best we remind you again early on. We have been offered a Ministry contract around Positive Behavior for Learning (Restorative Practice) focusing on building and maintaining positive, respectful relationships across the school community. It is based on a set of best practice tools and techniques to support a consistent and sustainable approach to managing positive, respectful relationships within the school. We are incredibly fortunate to be offered this which will help us strengthen our practice in this social skills area. A requirement of this professional learning is a Teacher Only Day which involves ALL staff, including all support staff, caretaker and admin staff. This is to introduce the package and develop the shared norms of practice that we are going to work towards.
